

Stereotypes & Prejudice

- Stereotype: a generalized picture of a person or a groups, created without taking the whole person or group into account; to make such a generalization
- Prejudice: a fixed, unreasonable, and unfair opinion of someone formed without sufficient knowledge & based on a stereotype(an actual judgement)
- Examples:
 - “All people with purple hair are not to be trusted.” (stereotype)
 - “I do not trust anyone with purple hair.” (prejudice)

*Discrimination occurs when prejudices are translated into action.
